

Code of Conduct

The Code is a minimum standard of ethical behavior for each of you, as you participate in the program and is to be embraced and co-enforced by each cohort member—an internal self-enforcement mechanism. This program is about Honor. Honor is a fundamental attribute of character. Honor is a virtue which impels loyalty and courage, truthfulness and self respect, justice and generosity. Its underlying principle is truth. It is not a complicated system of ethics, but merely honest dealing and clean thinking. If a cohort member is true in thought, word and deed, there is no question about his or her meeting the standards of this program. The Code is not constrained by any geographical boundaries—it travels with the participant wherever he or she goes.

Specifically :

- I will conduct myself in the highest professional standards (business casual dress is expected unless other wise directed).
- Engagement and dialog will be done with respect and honor.
- I will not use profanity and unprofessional language.
- I will not engage in inappropriate sexual activities, including refraining from sexual comments
- I will be respectful of scheduled events and honor starting and ending times.
- If I miss a session I will contact Dr. Collins or Hass as to the reason. If I miss more than 2 days/year the executive committee will decide if it is appropriate to continue.
- I will balance my curiosity with my defensiveness.
- I will drink responsibly and take care of my team if someone has had too much to drink.
- I will not leave any of my cohort in a risky situation.

My signature on this document indicates that I have read and fully understand the activities and my responsibilities as listed in this code of conduct. I also understand that participation in this program is a privilege, not a right, and if violate any conduct expectations of the program, including but not limited to the items on this Code of Conduct, that that I jeopardize my future involvement with this program. All incidences will be viewed and judged by the executive team as to consequences.
